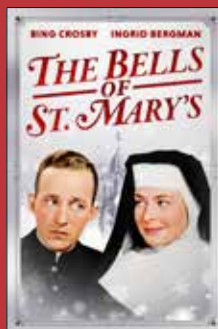

CRAFT IN AMERICA

December 19 at 8 and 9 p.m.

Celebrate the diversity of craft that defines America. *Craft in America: East* explores the intersection of history, culture and contemporary craft in the eastern region of the U.S. As a nation of immigrants, these American stories,

from a fabric flower factory to a silversmith to a potter and more, highlight the diverse expressions behind modern craft. Featured artists hail from Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Massachusetts.

West celebrates the continuum of heritage and the handmade, taking inspiration from the landscape, history and culture of the American West. Working across cowboy arts, Hawaiian indigenous practices, and Native American handwork, the makers show how traditional craft can be revived, reworked and reinvented in the art of today. The episode showcases artists in Texas, Hawaii, New Mexico and Idaho.
