It may sound strange, but I always look forward to the month of February. It is the last fully cold month of the season, and it holds the promise of spring. While the wind still carries a chill the sun stays out a little longer each day. In just a few weeks we'll be planting gardens and mowing the lawn. Until then KMOS PBS can still fill the chilly nights with some great programming. Here are a few programs coming in February that I think you will enjoy.

Sunday nights see the return of *Funny Woman*. Picking where season one left off, this series follows a young woman from a seaside town breaking into show business and improbably becoming the star of her own TV series in the 1960s. Having established herself as the nation's favorite TV comedy star and with her budding romance with Dennis on the right path, Sophie Straw's life is going great! But when her new sitcom flops, things start to go south.



On February 12th you can spend a whole night in ancient Egypt with NOVA and *Secrets of the Dead*! Follow archaeologists as they discover a long-lost ancient cemetery in Egypt's sacred desert. Treasures emerge unlike anything seen by the team, revealing details of a unique period when women had remarkable power. Then *Secrets of the Dead* follows a team of archaeologists as they examine a rare mass grave dating to the collapse of ancient Egypt's Old Kingdom, when political infighting and a changing climate brought down a dynasty in a moment of crisis and catastrophe.

On February 23 we have a special program featuring the life of the Dowager Countess herself Dame Maggie Smith. "*Discovering Maggie Smith*" looks at the remarkable on-screen career of Dame Maggie Smith (1934-2024), one of Britain's most prolific actresses. Smith was a prominent figure in British culture for six decades. Her extraordinary film career took off with her role in *Nowhere to Go* (1958), for which she received her first BAFTA nomination. Two Academy Awards later, including Best Actress for *The Prime of Miss Jean Brodie* (1969) and Best Supporting Actress for *California Suite* (1978), Smith had reached the pinnacle of success. Smith's later hit roles included Dowager Countess of Grantham in *Downton Abbey* and Professor Minerva McGonagall in the *Harry Potter* films.

While we look toward the spring this is just a small taste of the excellent program KMOS PBS has to offer this month. The only way that we can bring this programming to air in central Missouri is through the support of members like you and we thank you.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE The NAACP and Its Architects

February 25 at 8 p.m.

This documentary tells the story of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the most powerful civil rights organization ever created, through the key figures who shaped it. One of the most important but least

understood figures in civil rights history, Walter White, was the NAACP's longest reigning president. White clung to the belief that, for all its flaws, America held the seeds of its own redemption. When White took over the NAACP in 1929, Black Americans were socially and politically marginalized. By the time he died in 1955, they were a crucial segment of the electorate and on the brink of the landmark legal and legislative victories that would forever reshape the country. The NAACP and its leaders, including White, WEB DuBois, Thurgood Marshall and Charles Hamilton Houston, created a blueprint for America to follow to live up to its ideals.

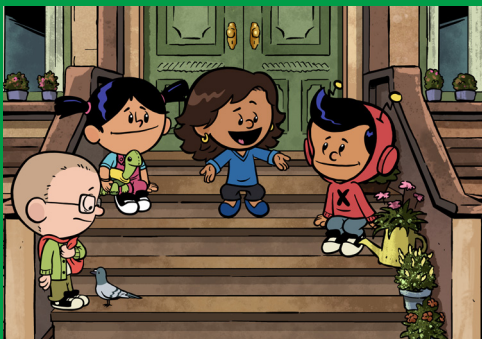
