ON THE COVER

***Wolf Hall: The Mirror and the Light* traces the final years of Thomas Cromwell's life and journey to become the most influential figure of his time under the notorious King Henry VIII. Jonathan Pryce, Kate Phillips, Lilit Lesser, and Thomas Brodie-Sangster return in their original roles for this six-part series.**

Henry's (Damian Lewis) regime is severely tested by religious rebellion at home, traitors plotting abroad, and the threat of invasion. Cromwell (Mark Rylance) must deftly navigate the moral complexities that accompany the exercise of power in this bloody time; he's caught between his desire to do what's right and his instinct to survive. The question is: how long can anyone survive under Henry's brutally mercurial gaze?

These are the three words used to describe PBS. For more than two decades PBS has been recognized as #1 in public trust. For 50 years PBS has endeavored to bring the best of news, arts, education and entertainment programming viewers across the country.

Some people say these are uncertain times when all times are uncertain for somebody. That is why at KMOS PBS we work hard to bring you the best that public media has to offer. In our viewing area nearly 70% of the population lives in communities of less than 2,500 people and 27% of the population is unserved or underserved by broadband internet access.

PBS is different from commercial media outlets as it is not a network. Rather, it is a non-profit membership organization that serves over 330 locally owned and operated member stations - rural, urban, large and small.

The thoughtful, educational and inspiring programming is produced by the stations and independent producers, then distributed through the PBS stations, reaching 96% of the U.S. population.

But our impact goes beyond the screens through local activities in your community, like the KMOS Young Writers contest (deadline March 31,) family day at Runge Nature Center in Jefferson City, and local screenings of *Independent Lens* and *America Outdoors*.

This is just a small example of why KMOS is a value to the community. All you need to watch high quality educational and entertaining programs is an antenna and a TV, or a mobile device.

This survey was developed by PBS and conducted online within the United States by Proof Insights (formerly M&RR) fielded 31 questions during the window of January 4-15, 2024. The survey was conducted among a sample of 1,019 adults ages 18+, 498 men, 517 women, and 4 respondents preferred to self-identify. The results are weighted to be nationally representative of the U.S. adult population.

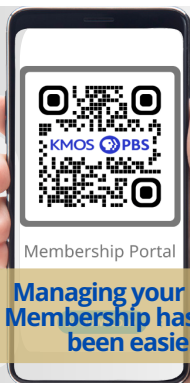

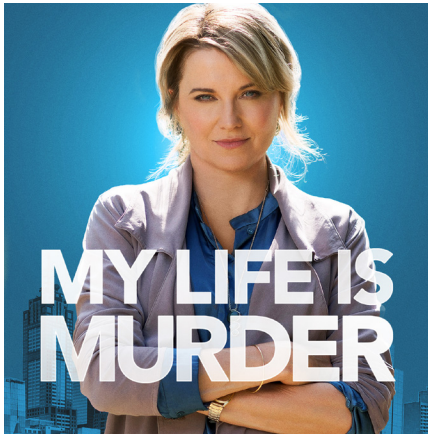

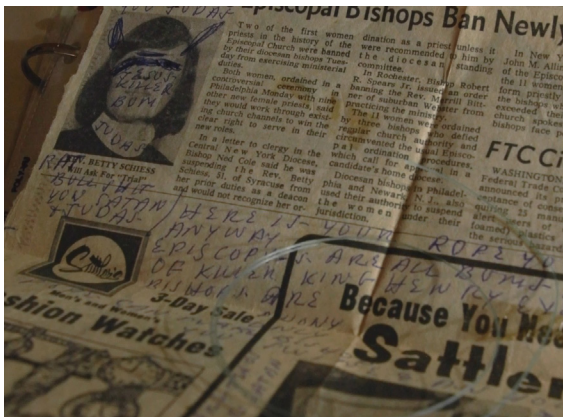
THE PHILADELPHIA ELEVEN MARCH 23 AT 6:30 P.M.

This largely unknown women's rights story introduces viewers to the trailblazers who challenged the very essence of patriarchy within Christendom and successfully created a blueprint for lasting institutional change.



The film chronicles how a group of women in the Episcopal Church shared a call to become priests. After two legislative votes to make it possible for women to be ordained failed, they organized their own ordination as priests in defiance of church norms.

Their ordination became not only a personal struggle but also a very public battle over whether women were qualified to lead. Despite the backlash, they successfully changed the church by asserting their leadership and a vision for a new way – on their own terms.



The Rev. Nancy H. Wittig was one of the Philadelphia Eleven featured in the movie. “It’s amazing that women are still fighting for rights in the church and continuing to feel blowback, similar to what we experienced 50 years ago,” she reflected. “We are proud of the changes we have accomplished through our priesthood and the ordinations in Philadelphia.”
