In 1993 coverage of the “Great Flood” was everywhere. There was one story that really caught my attention, the flooding of the cemetery in Hardin, MO. With a levy breaking and hundreds of caskets being disinterred and swept across the roads, farm fields and waterways, this story caught national attention. I was fascinated by it, not due to the “grizzly” narrative being portrayed but by the efforts of the community to return their loved ones to their final resting place.

Over the years, the disaster in the Hardin cemetery was featured in many programs. All these programs focused on the more scientific and clinical nature of the work: how the bodies were identified, and how they worked to recover them. To me one thing was always missing: the story of the people who did the work.



In 2019 we set out to talk to some of the people in the community and how they came together to bring their loved ones home. Through this process I learned how this event, in a small town in Missouri, went on to have an impact across the country. From airline crashes, to the September 11th attacks, the events at Hardin cemetery in 1993 set the stage for how to handle major disasters for years to come.

The story of the disaster and recovery of the Hardin cemetery is a unique Missouri story. At the heart of this story are the people who gave their time, effort and support to restore their community cemetery and peace to their loved ones.
