As summer comes to a close, we are looking forward to the fall and a great selection of new programs from PBS. Starting September 10th at 7 p.m. an all new season of *Big Cats* 24/7 where a team of local and international wildlife filmmakers use the latest technology to follow a group of African big cats in Botswana's awe-inspiring Okavango Delta. This six-part series reveals the lives of these big cats like never before. Also, On Wednesday September 10th at 9 p.m., join us for *Sacred Planet with Gulnaz Khan*. Famed journalist Gulnaz Khan examines the impact of climate change on sacred places around the world, meeting faith leaders who draw on ancient wisdom and spiritual resilience to confront the crisis with hope and action in this powerful four-part series.

This month we will be revisiting some classic PBS series including the Ken Burns documentary *Prohibition* Friday nights at 9 p.m. The 3-part, 5 1/2 hour documentary film series tells the story of the rise, rule, and fall of the 18th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and the era it encompassed. Coming Tuesday, September 9th at 7 p.m. is a special presentation of *American Experience: FDR*, telling the story of the longest-serving president in U.S. history. As the leader through the Great Depression and World War II, FDR is considered by many to be our greatest president.

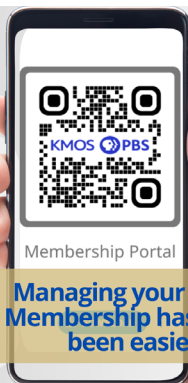

September 8 at 8:30 p.m.

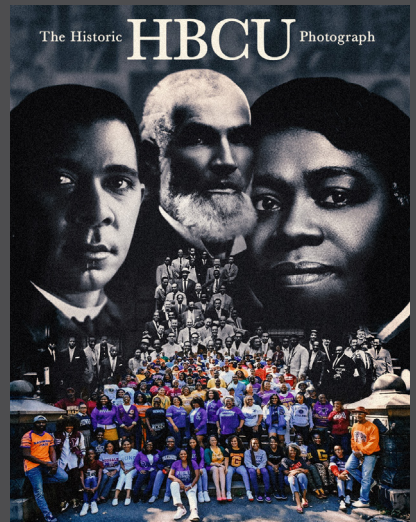
Learn about the changes, misconceptions, and current state of Historically Black Colleges and Universities through the personal stories of students and insights from experts. The documentary follows

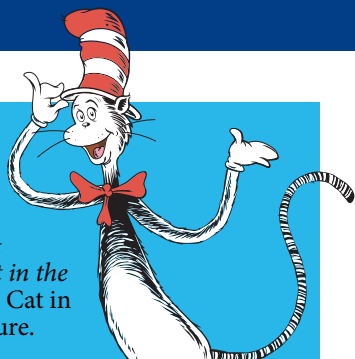
