for Sacred Planet with Gulnaz Khan. Famed journalist Gulnaz Khan examines the impact of climate change on sacred places around the world, meeting faith leaders who draw on ancient wisdom and spiritual resilience to confront the crisis with hope and action in this powerful four-part series.

This month we will be revisiting some classic PBS series including the Ken Burns documentary *Prohibition* Friday nights at 9 p.m. The 3-part, 5 1/2 hour documentary film series tells the story of the rise, rule, and fall of the 18th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and the era it encompassed. Coming Tuesday, September 9th at 7 p.m. is a special presentation of *American Experience*: FDR, telling the story of the longest-serving president in U.S. history. As the leader through the Great Depression and World War II, FDR is considered by many to be our greatest president.



As for local programming, on September 8th at 8 p.m. we will present a new documentary on the history of Lincoln University located in Jefferson City (pictured left). Founded in 1866 by African-American veterans of the American Civil War, it is a memberschool of the Thurgood Marshall College Fund. This was the first black university in the state.







Learn about the changes, misconceptions, and current state of Historically Black Colleges and Universities through the personal stories of students and insights from experts. The documentary follows


