ON THE COVER

April 30 marks the 50th anniversary of the fall of Saigon and the end of the Vietnam War.

The cover image is from a poster from a pre-release screening for our feature film *Manchu: A Brotherhood of Sacrifice*, airing Tuesday, April 29 at 7 p.m. on KMOS 6.1 (see page 7).

The film honors the men of the U.S. Army 4th Battalion, 9th Infantry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division who served during the Vietnam War.

At the center is Staff Sgt. Leonard Simpson of Oroville, CA, mentor to a young private named Stan Adams- one of the veterans featured in the film. He came to the attention of filmmaker Matt Wilcox through his book "Mokane to Mole City: A Manchu Vietnam Memoir Bravo Co. Nov. 1968 to Nov. 1969."

And - don't miss *The Vietnam War* Fridays at 8 p.m. beginning April 11. This 10-part film by Ken Burns & Lynn Novick previously aired in 2017.

I don't travel much for work, not because I don't like travel. I believe in what Mark Twain said, "Travel is fatal to prejudice, bigotry, and narrow-mindedness." I don't travel much for work because I prefer to dedicate every possible dollar we raise to programming. The cost of a single trip can pay for a season of *Doc Martin* on KMOS. However, this past month I felt compelled to pour myself into a very narrow, very inexpensive airline seat and stay at the cheapest hotel I could find to visit our nations capitol.

My mission wasn't a trade show or to meet the great Ken Burns (though that would have been quite cool.) It was to visit the lawmakers that serve KMOS PBS' viewing area. The purpose was to advocate for Federal funding for Public Broadcasting, which for KMOS represents nearly 40% of our annual budget. On my adventures to Capitol Hill, I was able to talk about our educational content, local programming and emergency message broadcasting. More importantly I was able to talk about how, like the lawmakers themselves, local PBS stations were meant to be representative of the communities they serve. I was able to demonstrate how curation of content available to KMOS brought viewers interesting



and informative programming not seen on other stations in the area. I was also able to discuss how our local programming like *Focus On* and *Making* brings attention to the artists, entrepreneurs, innovators and organizations that make central Missouri unique.

I am pleased to report that on my visit I did not meet a single person who was not appreciative of the work of KMOS PBS and other public broadcasters. They understand the essential work that we as a system do and, on the surface they seemed supportive. Whether this translates into actual support remains to be seen, but I can say that all the lawmakers and staffers I met with wanted to do what was best for the people of Missouri. MANCHU: A BROTHERHOOD OF SACRIFICE

PREMIERE TUESDAY, APRIL 29 AT 7 P.M.

On April 29, 1966 the U.S. Army 4th Battalion, 9th Infantry Regiment known as the “Manchus,” disembarked the ship USNS General Nelson M. Walker at Vung Tau, Vietnam and soon joined the 25th Infantry “Tropic Lightning” Division at Cù Chi Base Camp located northwest of Saigon.

The unit has a rich history extending back to 1799, but at the time that Stan Adams of Mokane, Missouri was drafted in 1968, the unit had just weathered a devastating battle on Thanksgiving eve. He was among the replacement troops assigned to help build a combat patrol base camp, nicknamed “Mole City,” near the Cambodian border.

Manchu: A Brotherhood of Sacrifice, a film by Matt Wilcox, recounts the story of the Manchus in Vietnam and pays tribute to the soldiers who served and sacrificed during the Vietnam War. It was fifty years ago on April 30 when the war ended. The many veterans who tell their stories in this film include David Hosenfelt, also of Callaway County. He was one of over 50 men wounded at the Thanksgiving battle which killed 18 Manchus and 6 crew members from the 187th Assault Helicopters (Crusaders.) Although Hosenfelt returned to the unit, he and Adams did not connect until years later back in Fulton, Missouri.

In May of 2024 this film was screened for over 400 people at a red-carpet event at William Woods University. During the ceremony, Manchu and other Vietnam veterans were recognized and the city of Fulton honored the ten Callaway County veterans and 428 Manchus who were killed in the war.



The genesis for this film began when Matt Wilcox (pictured left, with Manchu David Young) was a high school student interested in history. He asked his shop teacher, Manchu Steve Knowlton, to share about his deployment in Vietnam. Wilcox made a short film about the veteran's experiences and years later, reconnected with Knowlton to expand the story. They eventually partnered with Stan Adams, who wrote about his experiences in “Mokane to Mole City.” Stan and his wife Rita (Russell) Adams, worked with them to interview scores of veterans, research the details of the conflicts and make this incredible film.

STEP 1

Turn on your device and do a search for PBS. The PBS App should appear. Download it.



STEP 2

The first time you open the app, it will ask you to go to a website and type in a code. Go to your computer or mobile device and follow the instructions.

STEP 3

When it asks you to sign in, be sure to choose "Sign in with a PBS Account" and enter your email address and your password for Passport.

You can now watch all of the shows on the app! The next time you want to watch, just select the PBS app and choose a show (no sign-in required).
