This powerful documentary from the Missouri Humanities Council highlights the evolution of Missouri's highest court through the voices of its female judges—from the appointment of the first woman, the Honorable Ann Covington in 1989, to the historic female majority serving today. Missouri became the 14th state with a female majority Supreme Court in 2023. This film features the stories and contributions of Judges Mary Rhodes Russell, Robin Ransom, Ginger Gooch, Kelly Broniec, Patricia Breckenridge, Laura Stith, and Ann Covington.
