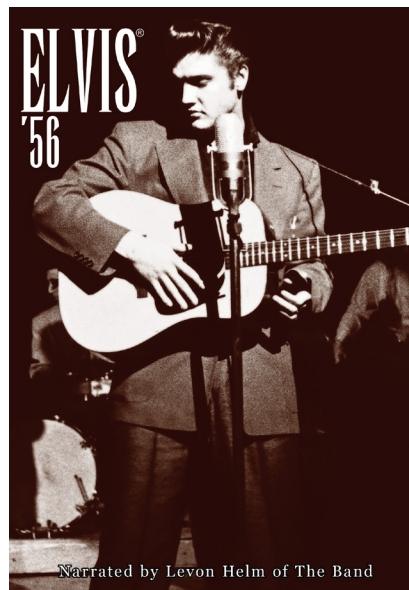
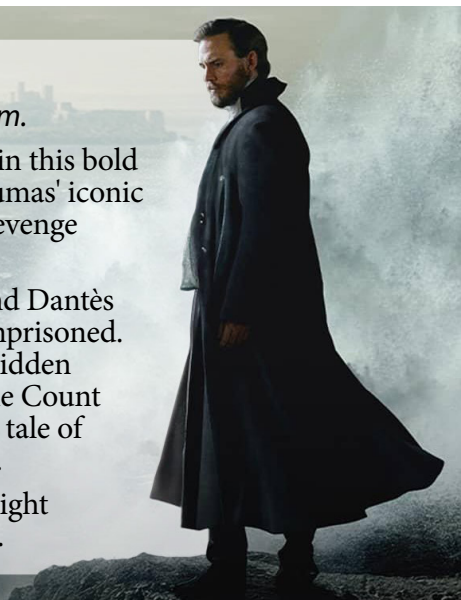
The Count of Monte Cristo

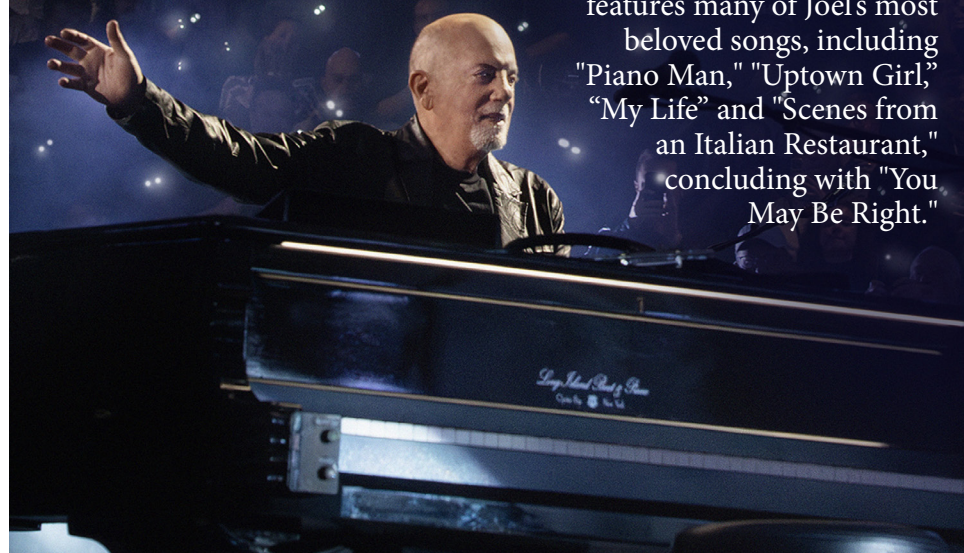

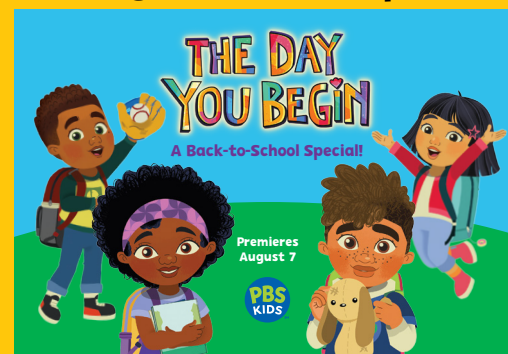
