When people say they love public media, they often mean how accessible it feels. Turn on the TV, and there it is, trusted news, children's programming, documentaries, and stories that reflect our community. But while public media is free to watch, it isn't free to create or sustain. Public media isn't free; it's public.

At its heart, public broadcasting exists to serve everyone. That means programming driven by education, curiosity, and community value rather than ratings or advertising. To make that possible, stations like KMOS PBS rely on a shared investment from the people we serve.

Behind our programming is a fully functional television studio. Cameras, lighting, sound equipment, editing systems, control rooms, and digital infrastructure all require constant upkeep and periodic replacement. Skilled engineers, producers, and educators work every day to ensure programming is accurate, accessible, and reliable. Add to that the technical demands of

broadcasting, transmitters, towers, power systems, and backup equipment, all necessary to deliver a clear signal across central Missouri, every day, in every season.

As a PBS member station, KMOS PBS also pays annual dues to PBS for access to national programming. These dues help fund the creation of the programs viewers trust and love, from children's educational content to in-depth documentaries and cultural series. Membership in PBS connects us to a national network, but it comes with real, ongoing costs.

What keeps public media accessible to all is community investment. When viewers support KMOS PBS, they ensure that education, trusted information, and local storytelling remain accessible to everyone, regardless of their income or background.

Public media belongs to the public. And when the community invests together, it stays strong, independent, and open to all.

King of Them All: The Story of King Records*February 20 at 9:30 p.m.*

Founded in 1943 by Syd Nathan, King Records reshaped the American musical landscape by recording country, rhythm & blues, and rock 'n' roll under one roof—at a time when the music industry, and the nation itself, was divided by race and genre. The label launched the careers of legendary artists, including James

Brown, Wynonie Harris, Hank Ballard, Little Willie John, The Stanley Brothers, and countless others whose influence can still be heard today.


Blending rare archival footage, newly colorized film reels, hand-drawn 1950s-style animation, and exclusive interviews with musicians, historians, and industry veterans, *King of Them All* is both a love letter to Cincinnati and a testament to King Records' outsized role in shaping global popular music.

Director and Producer Yemi Oyediran said, "This film is about giving long-overdue recognition to the visionaries who changed American culture from right here in Cincinnati, and it has been an honor to bring their voices and legacies to the screen through the PBS platform."

The film underscores the Midwest's central role in American music history and features commentary from Vince Gill, Christian McBride, Seymour Stein, Tammy Kernodle, Alan Leeds, Clyde Brown, Daru Jones, John Curley, and others, alongside newly unearthed perspectives from the families of King Records' artists and staff.


