September changes the pace of life. School is back. Vacations are over. The evenings stretch a little longer, making it easier to settle into a favorite chair and spend an hour with a great story. That's exactly what awaits this month on KMOS PBS. A new season is beginning, bringing fresh mysteries, remarkable true stories, and the kind of thoughtful television that has always set public media apart.

Sunday nights belong to MASTERPIECE once again. The new season begins September 6 with *The Marlow Murder Club* at 7:00 p.m., followed by *Marble Hall Murders* at 8:00 p.m. Two smart mysteries. Two hours you'll want to clear your schedule for. Then, on September 20, *Trespases* arrives. Set in Belfast in 1975, it follows Cushla, a Catholic schoolteacher whose affair with a married Protestant pulls her between family, faith, and the life she wants for herself.

The rest of the week keeps the momentum going. *American Experience* revisits the lives behind some of the West's most enduring legends, from Billy the Kid to Bonnie & Clyde and Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid. *NOVA* explores the breakthrough that transformed the treatment of cystic fibrosis before turning to the ingenuity of Indigenous communities whose knowledge has shaped life across North America for generations. Mondays bring compelling documentaries from *POV* and *Independent Lens*, taking on subjects as personal as family loss and as

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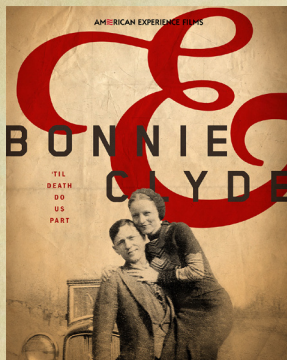

UNCOVER THE REAL STORIES

Henry McCarty, a.k.a. Billy the Kid, electrified the nation with a long line of daring escapes from jailers. Demonized by the lawman that finally killed him, the Kid was soon mythologized by dime store novels and big-screen dramas. But in all the tellings, Billy the Kid's real story has been obscured.

Discover the true story of Bonnie & Clyde, the most famous outlaw couple in US history. Though their exploits were romanticized, the Barrow gang was believed responsible for at least 13 murders, including two policemen, as well as robberies and kidnappings.

Long before they were immortalized on screen, Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid captivated Americans. Their thrilling exploits became front-page news and the basis of rumor and myth. Marble Hall Murders on Masterpiece Premieres Sundays at 8 p.m.

Good news for fans of Anthony Horowitz's intricate, ingenious mysteries. *Marble Hall Murders*, the third and final installment of the Susan Ryeland series, is coming to *Masterpiece* on KMOS PBS. Lesley Manville and Tim McMullan return for a six-episode event that promises an unforgettable final chapter.

Marble Hall Murders reunites audiences with the clever meta world first brought to life in *Magpie Murders* (2022) and *Moonflower Murders* (2024).

"I'm so happy to bring the team back... for a third instalment of what has been a fantastically successful TV series," said Anthony Horowitz. "I have a feeling this could be the best yet."

In *Marble Hall Murders*, editor Susan Ryeland is pulled into a new literary puzzle when she's hired to work on a continuation novel in the Atticus Pünd series, penned by a troubled young writer. But when the assignment draws her into another very real murder case, Susan soon finds herself cast as a suspect. Meanwhile, within the world of the novel, the enigmatic detective Atticus Pünd travels to the Isle of Corfu where he becomes embroiled in the murder of Lady Margaret Chalfont.
