Turn on your device and do a search for PBS. The PBS App should appear. Download it.



STEP 2

The first time you open the app, it will ask you to go to a website and type in a code. Go to your computer or mobile device and follow the instructions.

STEP 3

When it asks you to sign in, be sure to choose "Sign in with a PBS Account" and enter your email address and your password for Passport.*

WATCH

You can now watch all of the shows on the app! The next time you want to watch, just select the PBS app and choose a show (no sign-in required).

Go to kmos.org then select "KMOS Sign In" and click on "KMOS Passport."

On the Passport page, click "Sign In" then choose your method to sign in (PBS Account, Google, Facebook, or Apple).

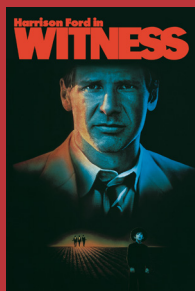

Take a look back at some of the great country music duet performers of all time. Join hosts Tre Twitty and Tayla Lynn (Conway Twitty's grandson & Loretta Lynn's granddaughter - pictured below)

for a walk down memory lane as they explore the musical partnerships and vocal harmonies that defined an era of country music.

This special begins with the fruitful vocal match-up of singer/songwriter Dolly Parton and the blond-pompadoured Porter Wagoner. At 21 years old, Parton joined Wagoner's TV show, beginning a musical partnership that earned them vocal duo of the year in 1970 and resulted in 20 hit singles throughout the early '70s.

Tre and Taylor then take a look at the musical dynamic that resulted from the mix of George Jones' smooth baritone and Tammy Wynette's emotional twang. Though Jones and Wynette married and divorced during their tumultuous personal relationship, they continued to work together professionally, recording nine duet albums together.

Lastly, Country's Legendary Duets looks back at the hit duets of country music icons Loretta Lynn and Conway Twitty. From 1971-1981, this musical partnership produced 13 top-10 hits, including "Louisiana Women, Mississippi Man" and the Grammy-winning "After the Fire is Gone."

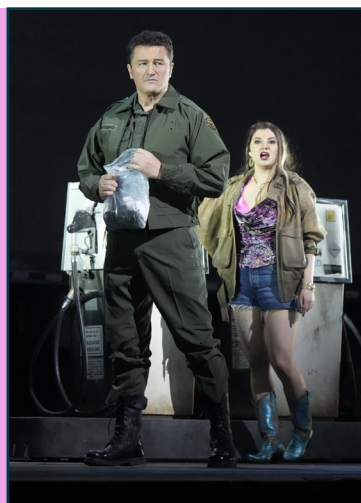

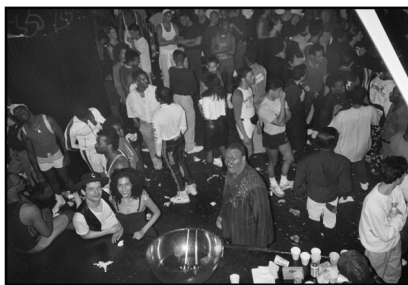


The surprising and overlooked history of disco – the preeminent popular music of the 1970s. This docuseries captures the story of disco: its rise, its fall, and its legacy. From the basement bars of '70s New York City to the peak of the global charts, along with iconic tracks and remarkable footage, this

three-part series offers a powerful, revisionist history of the disco age.

Disco embodied the height of 1970s glamour: a dance floor culture born in New York City that went on to take over the world. But its success also obscured its wider significance. Inextricably bound up with the major liberation movements of the 1970s, disco speaks to some of the biggest issues of today: LGBTQ+ identity and female empowerment.

Disco: Soundtrack of a Revolution also underscores disco's survival. Co-opted by the commercial mainstream, the genre dominated and flooded the market – the airwaves and record shops – leading to a subsequent hate-fueled backlash. As a result, the music and its ethos went back underground, where it evolved into an electronic dance sound that laid the foundations for contemporary dance culture.
