Nolly, starring Helena Bonham Carter debuts on Sunday, March 17, 2024 at 8 p.m. The Guardian (UK) calls Bonham Carter’s performance “brilliantly camp” and the series itself “impeccably put together.”

Nolly on Masterpiece reveals the story of Noele “Nolly” Gordon, one of the most famous faces on British TV in the 1960s and 70s, whose unceremonious firing from her hit show at the height of her career was front-page news. A bold exploration of how the establishment turns on women who refuse to play by the rules, *Nolly on Masterpiece* is an outrageously fun and wildly entertaining ride through Gordon’s most tumultuous years, and a sharp, affectionate, and heart-breaking portrait of a forgotten icon.

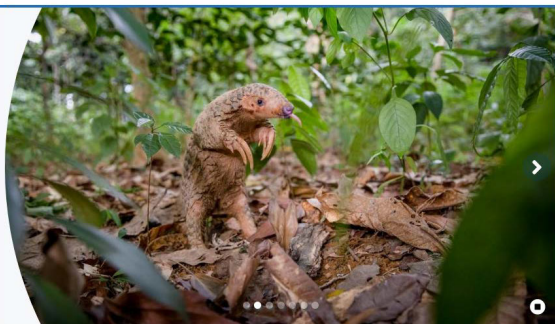

Man in the Moon:

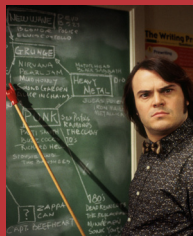
(Sam Waterston; Tess Harper; Gail Strickland; Reese Witherspoon; Jason London)

What began as a bitter dispute over Union and States' Rights, ended as a struggle over the meaning of freedom in America.

Ken Burns uses contemporary cinematography alongside thousands of archival photographs, paintings, and newspaper images set to music to teach people about the American Civil War. A number of well-known actors and actresses lend their voices to the production as they read contemporary quotes from historical figures, including President Abraham Lincoln and General Stonewall Jackson.
