
He explores the Acropolis in Athens with legendary comedian Harry Hill, the Colosseum in Rome with comedian and presenter Tom Allen

SPACE: THE LONGEST GOODBYE



Follow NASA's real-life attempts to prepare astronauts for a journey to meet the goal of sending astronauts to Mars. It's a journey that would require a three-year absence from Earth, during which communication in real time would be impossible due to the immense distance. In this documentary we meet the psychologists whose job is to keep astronauts mentally stable in outer space, as they are caught between their dream of reaching new frontiers and their basic human need to stay connected to home.

In the next decade, NASA intends to send astronauts to Mars for the first time. To succeed, crew members must overcome unprecedented lifethreatening challenges. And while many of these hazards are physical, the most elusive are psychological. Throughout their three-year absence, crew members won't be able to

communicate with Earth in real time due to the immense distance. The psychological impact of this level of disconnectedness and isolation - both from mission control and loved ones - is impossible to predict, endangering the mission itself.

Directed to mitigate this threat is Dr. Al Holland, a NASA psychologist "It's a documentary about courage, intelligence, community, and trust for those brave enough and willing to reach new frontiers. But most importantly, it is about sacrifice."
