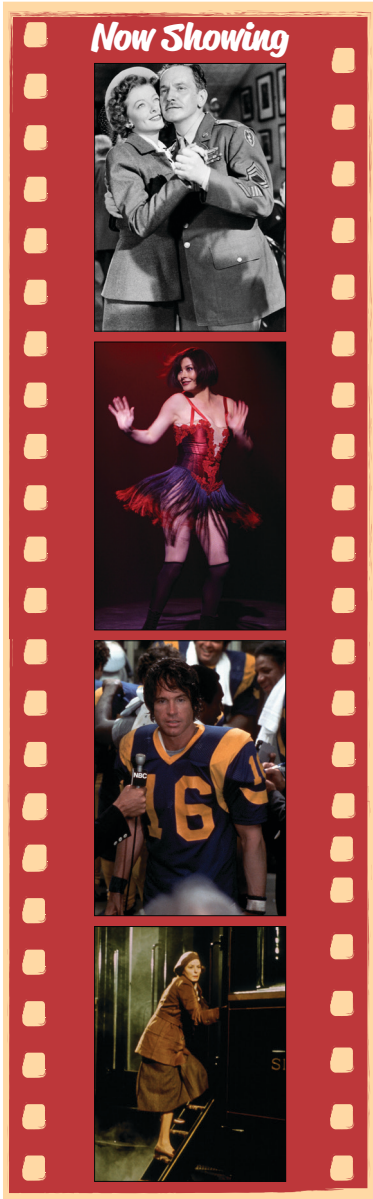

Turn on your device and do a search for PBS. The PBS App should appear. Download it.



STEP 2

The first time you open the app, it will ask you to go to a website and type in a code. Go to your computer or mobile device and follow the instructions.

STEP 3

When it asks you to sign in, be sure to choose "Sign in with a PBS Account" and enter your email address and your password for Passport.

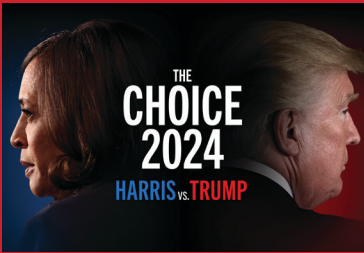

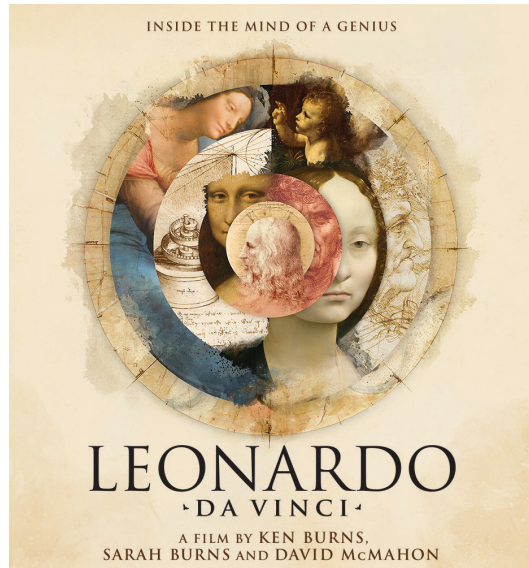

This new film from Ken Burns explores the life and work of the 15th century polymath Leonardo da Vinci.
