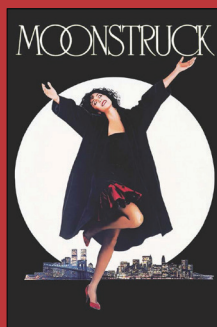

Experience 1980s Cold War tensions and the threat of a global nuclear apocalypse through the lens of a commercial television network, as it narrowly succeeds in producing the most-watched, most-controversial TV movie ever made, *The Day After* (1983). The primetime film was of great interest to viewers in west-central Missouri as Whiteman Air Force Base was then responsible for over 100 U.S. nuclear missiles and

control facilities in the region - and a target for a Soviet strike. *Television Event* shows how *The Day After* captured the public imagination and forced an urgent conversation with the President Reagan on how to collectively confront and resolve the most pressing issue of nuclear proliferation.

In 1983, ABC began production on *The Day After*, a made-for-TV movie starring Jason Robards, JoBeth Williams and John Lithgow and directed by Nicholas Meyer. As a dramatization of the effects of nuclear war on the ordinary American people, the film's producers had no idea of the obstacles and opposition they would face, or of the enduring impact it would have once broadcast - both in the U.S. and in Russia.

Royal History

September 13, starting at 8 p.m.

Edward VIII: Britain's Traitor King - Edward VIII is most famous for his abdication, less than a year after being crowned King, in 1936. But what happened afterwards is where the true scandal lies. This film reveals the extent of the Duke of Windsor's treachery during World War II.

New documents have led historians to believe that the Duke was passing wartime information to known spies and calling for Britain to be bombed into submission, while an unearthed BBC broadcast shows Edward calling for peace between Britain and Germany weeks before the outbreak of war. Post-war, there was a cover-up of the whole affair. Wallis



Simpson was always painted as the villain of the piece, which conveniently drew attention and scrutiny away from Edward.



My King Charles - This film features stories and insights from people close to the King at the most pivotal moments of his life. The film includes unpublished personal letters and photographs and new revelations from those closest to him, including former girlfriends, relatives and former private staff, painting a uniquely intimate picture of the real man behind the crown.

Led by Contois, the character-driven drama features a talented cast of Indigenous actors, including Ellyn Jade, Osawa Muskwa, Joshua Odjick, Imajyn Cardinal, Braeden Clarke, Eric Schweig and Michelle Thrush. Rounding out the cast is Lisa Edelstein plays Esther's adoptive mother, Golda Rosenblum.
